1. Briefly share a time when you were faced with a seemingly impossible situation. Talk about how you processed that event / how you felt and what you did. What was the outcome?
2. Who did Daniel enlist for help and prayer when he found himself faced with an impossible situation? Who are the people you turn to when you have a challenge that seems impossible to overcome?
3. Share a time when you called out to God and He answered you. How did that experience give you confidence and faith to ask Him for what you need?
4. After Daniel prayed to God, God revealed to him what the king's dream was and what it meant. As a result of Daniel's sharing that revelation with the king, others were saved and the king praised Daniel's God. Who in your life does God want you to talk to about Him?
5. How do we overcome the things that keep us from sharing what God has shown us?
6. Which of the eight steps that Daniel took when he was asked to do the impossible feels most challenging for you? How can you go about strengthening this dimension of your life?
7. Daniel's choices ultimately resulted in God's name being glorified (Daniel refused to take any credit for what God had done). Discuss the character traits that will lead you to do what Daniel did.
8. Daniel's life reflected how important it was to him to see others saved. How can we cultivate a heart's desire to see others enter into the life and hope we have in Christ?
9. What motivation can we nurture in our hearts in order for our lives to have the same impact for elevating God's name, the same integrity in serving God, and the same impact on those in our network of relationships?
